A vast amount of research is conducted from this archipelago and have produced a bunch of new species -- all new to science.
The Holotype of quercinus seem to have higher spire...probably a juvenile of the species. Cracked section of the outer lip and marked with blue permanent marker...labeled F.F.S. 12.20.86. (French Frigate Shoals)
