A extraordinarily well-preserved Middle Miocene (~14.5 million years) Australian volute Conus ligatus Tate, 1890 47.5 mm, Victoria, Australia, is now available. This is an incredible species with truly unique spiral sculpture, quite intact in this specimen, and crisp spiral cordlets forming a cadence from top to base.
