

A extraordinarily well-preserved Middle Miocene (~14.5 million years) Australian volute *Conus ligatus* Tate, 1890 47.5 mm, Victoria, Australia, is now available. This is an incredible species with truly unique spiral sculpture, quite intact in this specimen, and crisp spiral cordlets forming a cadence from top to base. Some loss to the lip (which is the case in the vast majority of specimens), but overall very good condition
