An exquisite and beautifully preserved specimen of the Middle Miocene (~14.5 million years) Australian volute Ternivoluta anticingulata (McCoy, 1866) 63.3 mm, Victoria, Australia, is now available. This is in absolutely outstanding condition for its age, and is a fossil extremely rarely on offer. It is in exquisite condition - the lower lip is chipped, but otherwise this specimen is hard to fault. Very hard to find, and a must for an advanced fossil and/or volute collector.
