Ericusa hamiltonensis (Pritchard, 1898) 66.7 mm, Victoria, now available. This is a very rare Ericusa species, and extremely rare in fully adult condition and with lip intact. This is, however, a subadult specimen where there is damage to the lip (hence the low start price). It is nevertheless an important fossil volute from the fabled Victorian Middle Miocene (15 million years) fauna.
