Conus anabathrum Crosse, 1865

LOCATION: Collected at minus low tide on exposed muddy sand flat, Goodland Bay, Goodland, Florida, December 26th, 2011.

SIZE: 55.4 mm HUGE !!! Also including a 39.3mm normal sized specimen that was collected the same day, this shell is shown in two of the photos for size comparison.

QUALITY: F+/F++ A one time opportunity to get this giant shell, the largest I have ever seen! I have only collected a few of these cones over 50 mm in size, they are rare to get this large. Both these shells were found fresh dead. The giant shell has a few chips on the lip & a scar at the shoulder near the lip edge. You can see the flaws easily in the photos. The smaller shell also has some chipping along the lip edge
