Conus tmetus Tomlin

Flawless beautiful specimen, perfect apex and natura outer lip.

The milk-chocolate, melanistic form has always been saught after by collectors for its elegance.

This form is endemic to Solomones and Vanuatu, at a diving depth. The problem is rhe scarcity of divers in loco,

hence supply is nowadays quite hard.

Remarks: was C.pilkeyi Petuch. When it was discovered conspecificity with its juvenile form (C. tmetus) the oldest name took back priority.
