Conus sandwichensis--Hawaiian Cone-Walls, 1978.

SIZE & GRADE: 35.99mm. Damaged, but still totally displayable.

LOCATION: North Shore, Oahu in beach wash in the big surf winter of 1975.

COMMENTS: excellent ultra rare Endemic cone with outstanding protoconch and fantastic coloration considering the pounding that it took in 40 foot surf. Unfortunately, the lip has a chip at the very tip. There is some ground in stain and a few rub marks on the bottom of the shell, but the upper side is still outstanding and makes this a rather nice display shell. Larger than average size for the species.
