

Cymatium caribbaeum 60mm

Cymatium (Ranularia) caribbaeum (Clench & Turner, 1957), Eleuthera Island, Bahama Islands, dived in 2m depth on sandy bottom with exuberant growth of seagrass, live taken specimen shell.

Description: From an excellent collection of Ranellidae formed in Switzerland two decades ago, a specimen in all natural condition, diver picked in June 1989, and very beautiful. Always was rare to find and the situation did not change in recent years making this one of the more difficult targets for the Ranellidae collector especially this nice condition which seems to come exclusively from old and well groomed collections.
