

*C. aurantium*; (Gmelin 1791). This shell was found 22 meters deep on the ocean wall at Kwajalein Atoll in the Republic of the Marshall Islands. Specimen measures 88.4 mm digital. Stress fractures on base and margins evident in scans are far less visible to the naked eye. The most noticeable imperfections are the dorsal surface inclusions (white spots) and a pair of chips in the anterior canal which are covered with the glossy evidence of early repair efforts. Overall, it remains a fair specimen for such a rare find. Data included.
