

***Bistolida diauges fulva*, Bozzetti 2009**

**Super yellow! Rare form! 25.4 mm F++/Gem**

**Salary. Madagascar. Madagascar, the village of Salary not only produces the occasionally very blue stolida called salaryensis, but also a variant of the stolida which is white and brownish. Fulva means reddish yellow or yellow. And the shell shown in Malacologia where this form has been described by Bozzetti as *Bistolida stolida salaryensis* f. *fulva* shows a rather brown yellowish specimen - much as an overglazed piece**
