Super yellow! Rare f0rm! 25.4 mm F++/Gem Salary. Madagascar. Madagascar, the village of Salary not only produces the occasionally very blue stolida called salaryensis, but also a variant of the stolida which is white and brownish. Fulva means reddish yellow or yellow. And the shell shown in Malacologia where this form has been described by Bozzetti as Bistolida stolida salaryensis f. fulva shows a rather brown yellowish specimen - much as an overglazed piece
