Mauritia Maculifera Hawaiiensis(Depressed Form) (Schilder & Schilder, 1937). Location: S.E. Shore, Oahu, HI. Grade: F+++/Gem 61.0x46.0mm. Notes: Night dive in 10ft back in a crack in the reef, snuck in on a calm day as the waves normally go 30ft or more up the sheer rock face, thus over time making these more depressed to help them secure themselves. This Mac is DEPRESSED and is only 15.0mm less wide than it is long, VERY PRONOUNCED THICK winged margins with excellent stretch marks & spots and can hold the side margin in your finger tips, also very DARK, very thick margins, nice defined mantel line. Don't let this DEPRESSED Mac slip through your fingers.
