61.3mm. Penneshaw, Kangaroo Island, South Australia at depth 23 meters in 2007. Fully mature, heavy- 32 gramms, very old shell with milkish coloration and some tiny overglazed dust on the back due to age. Well colored shell with plenty dark dots on the back. Tiny overglazed mark on posterior terminal nearly invisible on last photos. F+++/Gem- Shell has typical for population of Kangaroo Island picture on the back - bigger dark dots in comparing with shells from Thorny Passage area. Shells from this location have very distinct pattern on the back.

## Advanced zoila collectors must have both forms:

Impossible to get this specie in this size and such a nice conditions in modern days. There are no more official shell divers in South Australia. Moreover - Kangaroo Island is Marine Park now - no collecting
