This has got to be the strangest sakurarii I've ever seen. While the shell appears to be gem, it has virtually no pattern, just the faintest suggestion of some light brown blotches. Yet, it is certainly not an albino, and also does NOT appear to be faded at all. The specimen is actually quite shiny. It is beautiful in its own right and cannot possibly be anything else---hirasei and teremachii have different teeth and shapes. Certainly the price is right. A true "one of a kind!" F+++
