

A well-preserved Middle Miocene (~14.5 million years) Australian volute *Conus ligatus* Tate, 1890 43.7 mm, Victoria, Australia, is now available. This is an incredible species with truly unique spiral sculpture, quite intact in this specimen, and crisp spiral cordlets forming a cadence from top to base. The lip is unfortunately not intact (it hardly ever is in this species), and there are some minor impurities as shown in the photos, but overall the piece is in very good condition.
