Galeodea gradata 30.7 (Tate, 1889) 28 mm, Victoria, Australia. Age: Middle Miocene (approximately 14.5 million years). This is a very rarely offered species, and an example in absolutely exquisite condition (please see photos for more information). Note in particular the long, perfectly intact siphonal canal. Superb!
