an impressive piece of the very rare Australian cowrie Umbilia eximia (Tate, 1889) 94.3 mm, Victoria. Age: Middle Miocene epoch, approximately 14.5 million years. This piece is in very good condition and of good size, with the characteristic and commanding siphons well-developed and exhibiting great maturity. I urge close examination of the photos provided for a comprehensive description of the condition of this exquisite fossil. Suited for an advanced fossil collection.
