A very well preserved specimen of the Middle Miocene (~14.5 million years) Australian volute Alcithoe sarissa Tate, 1889) 50.6 mm, Victoria, Australia, is now available. This is a juvenile specimen as evidenced by the immature lip, hence the very low asking price. In any condition or level of maturity this is a very hard to find species, and a must for an advanced fossil and/or volute collector.
