Lyria harpularia Tate, 1889, an exquisite and beautifully preserved specimen of the Middle Miocene (~14.5 million years) Australian 22.4 mm, Victoria, Australia, now available. This is in absolutely outstanding condition for its age, and is a fossil very rarely offered at auction. It has some minor impurities, but is largely intact and with sculpture as sharp and prominent as if it was collected yesterday.
