

**Marginellona gigas 142 mm LARGE, very good for species**

This species is notoriously hard to get without any problems. The very thin lip chips easily and the shell is subject to growth and rest lines, which are often outlined in black. This particular specimen has a tiny chip in the lip, as shown, and a few mends in the spire, also as shown, but NO mends in the large body whorl, which is exceptional. The color is wonderful, a brownish battleship grey with a definite shine.
