Natica acinonyx Marche-Marchad, 1957

One of the most wonderful Naticids, very saught after by collectors but rare enough, seldom offered and usually very rusty stained. This is a giant specimen from old collection, unfortunately without operculum but giant and with a striking nice pattern of coalescing chocolate spotting on a warm orange ground.

Not to miss, hardly such nice!
