Sri Lanka. Very beautiful and heavy. Amazing orange and red base with upper callus, red aperture with orange canal, very mature orange lip. Turbinella pyrum comorinensis representing a population endemic to South Sri Lanka, characterized, with normal species, by an elegant pattern of spiral bands of black spots (actual only for small specimens), short siphonal channel and by smaller size. A heavy, massive shell its normal size a around 20-25 cm. It is specimen a DWARF size
