Cymbiola irvinae (EA Smith, 1909) F++, 63.5 mm collected by ROV in southern Western Australia now available. This is a crabbed specimen, but in quite good condition (note in particular the sharp shoulder spines and the stunning peach and lemon colouration) and certainly a good representative should you not have this rare species in your collection. The lip has been trimmed and there are minor blemishes, relatively minor, hence the very low asking price for this coveted species.
