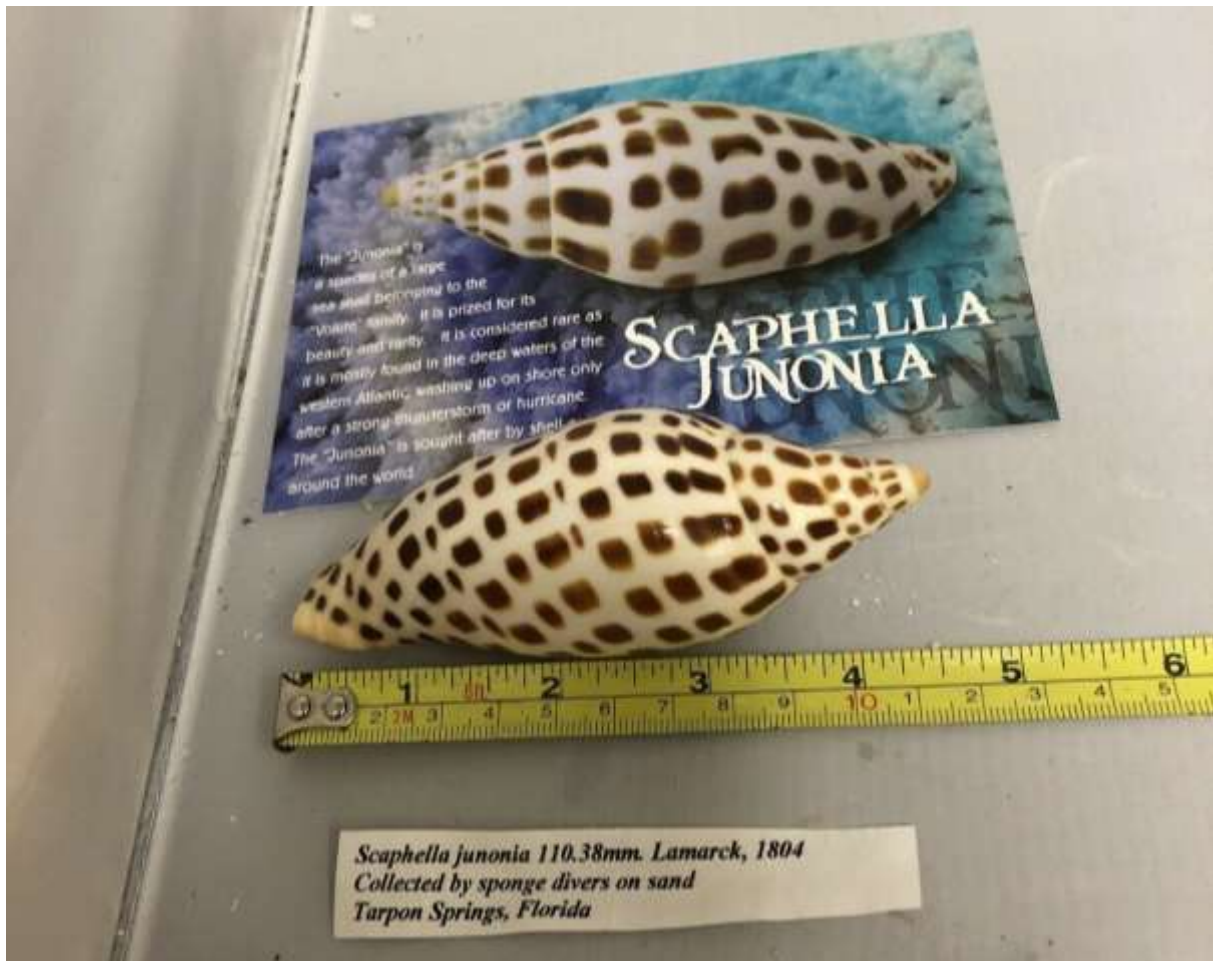


Scaphella junonia

The "Junonia" is a species of a large sea shell belonging to the "Voluta" family. It is prized for its beauty and rarity. It is considered rare as it is mostly found in the deep waters of the western Atlantic, washing up on shore only after a strong thunderstorm or hurricane. The "Junonia" is sought after by shell collectors around the world.
